If you have any questions, please contact me or the store for assistance. Most of the stores will allow your child try different instruments to see which one they would like to play.

You will also need to purchase the band book. The book we are using this year is called "Standard of Excellence: book 1." If you know what instrument your child is playing, just tell the rental assistant the book title and the instrument, and they will know which one to get.





MAINTENANCE AGREEMENT - RENTAL: While you are renting this instrument, we will maintain the instrument in playing condition, provided damages are not willful or due to negligence and provided the payments are current at the time of the damages. Maintenance coverage shall include dents on brass instruments, repair of cracked joints on wood clarinets, 50% off replacement of broken drumheads, 50% off broken bridges on violin, viola and cello, 30% off upright bass bridges and 50% of the retail of broken strings on violins, violas, cellos and basses: re-hair of bows on stringed instruments. Broken parts of the instrument such as the neck and cracks in the body are repaired at half the retail price however the customer maybe liable for a depreciation or replacement charge if the instrument is deemed to be "severely damaged" or "damaged beyond repair". Maintenance coverage does not include restoration of finishes or replacement of expendable items such as cases, reeds, straps, lubricants, etc. The company or our designated agent must make any and all repairs and replacements. This maintenance agreement is paid monthly and will be cancelled if payments are not current. No other repair shop may work on the instrument and any repairs, damages, or alterations so incurred shall be fully chargeable to the customer. This maintenance agreement will terminate when rental agreement is terminated or cancelled.

When renting an instrument from Graner, here are few things to remember:

- 1) You must pay the 1st month rental when getting the instrument at the store.
- 2) It's a month to month rental purchase. This means you may take the instrument back anytime to stop payment.
- 3) If you rent a NEW instrument, the first year of rental goes to the purchase of the instrument.
- 4) You cannot buy a USED instrument from Graner, just rent a used one.
- 5) The basic monthly rental for the instrument is 25 65 dollars.
